Companies operate responsibly



HUMAN RIGHTS

1. Businesses should support and respect the protection of internationally proclaimed human rights; and
2. make sure that they are not complicit in human rights abuses.



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3. Businesses should uphold the freedom of association and the effective recognition of the right to collective bargaining;
4. the elimination of all forms of forced and compulsory labour;
5. the effective abolition of child labour; and
6. the elimination of discrimination in respect of employment and occupation.



ENVIRONMENT

7. Businesses should support a precautionary approach to environmental challenges;
8. undertake initiatives to promote greater environmental responsibility; and
9. encourage the development and diffusion of environmentally friendly technologies.



ANTI-CORRUPTION

10. Businesses should work against corruption in all its forms, including extortion and bribery.

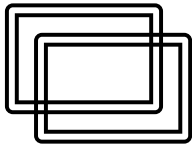

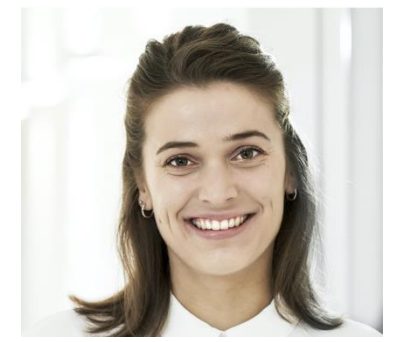

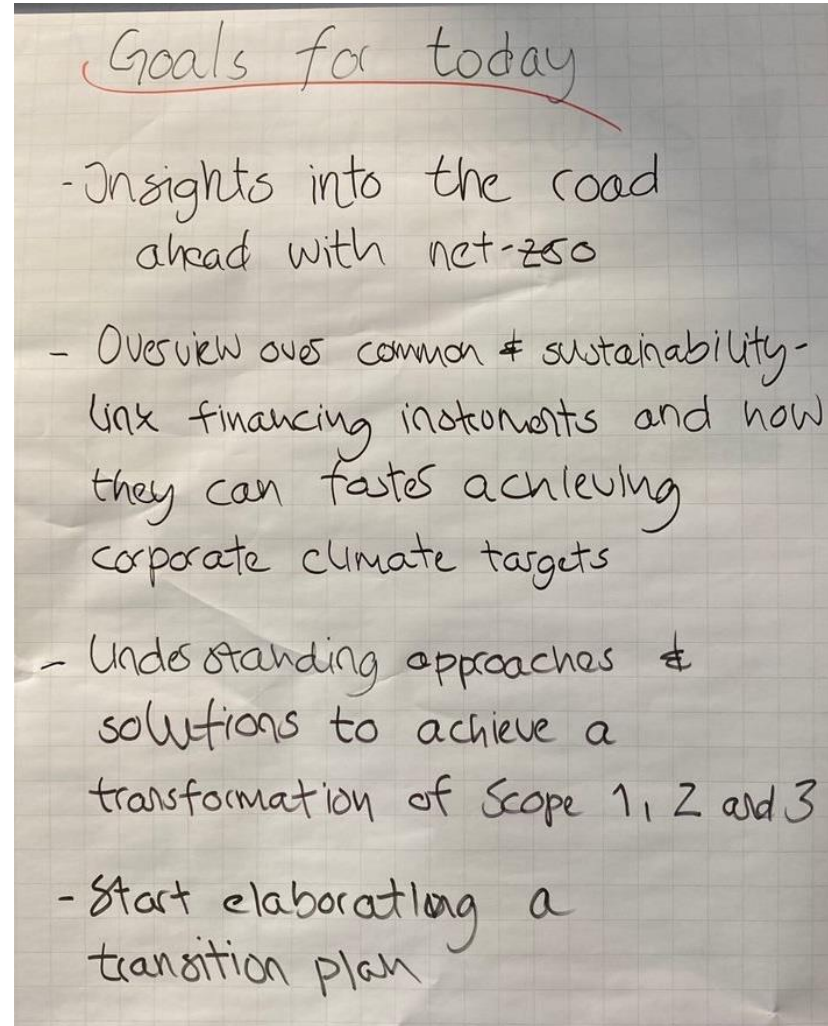

- 2** Networks and collaborations are THE key for successful transformation if business models
- 3** The financing gap in achieving Net-Zero climate targets cannot be closed with existing and commonly used financial instruments.

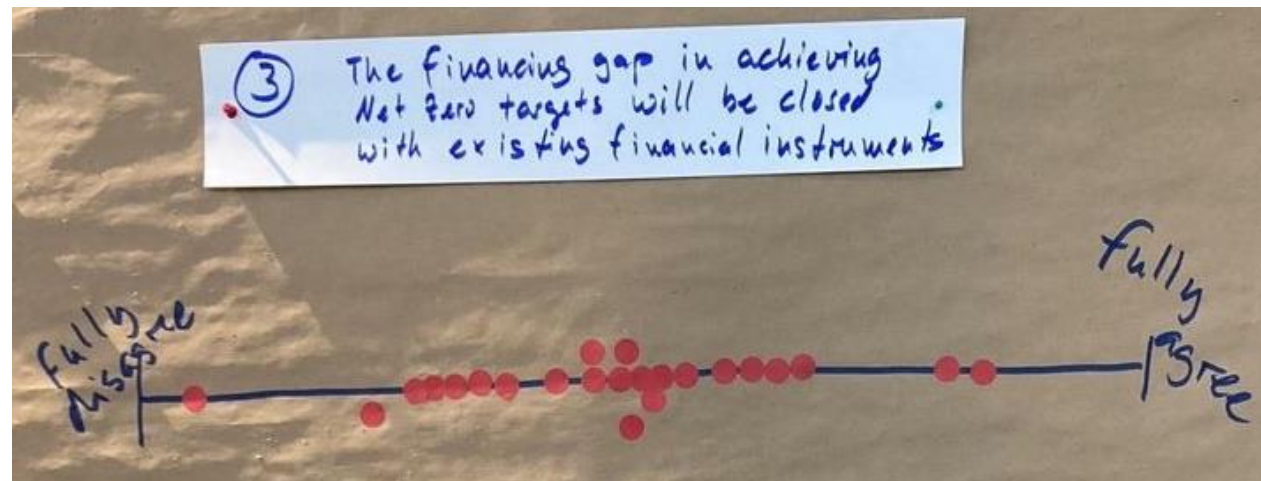
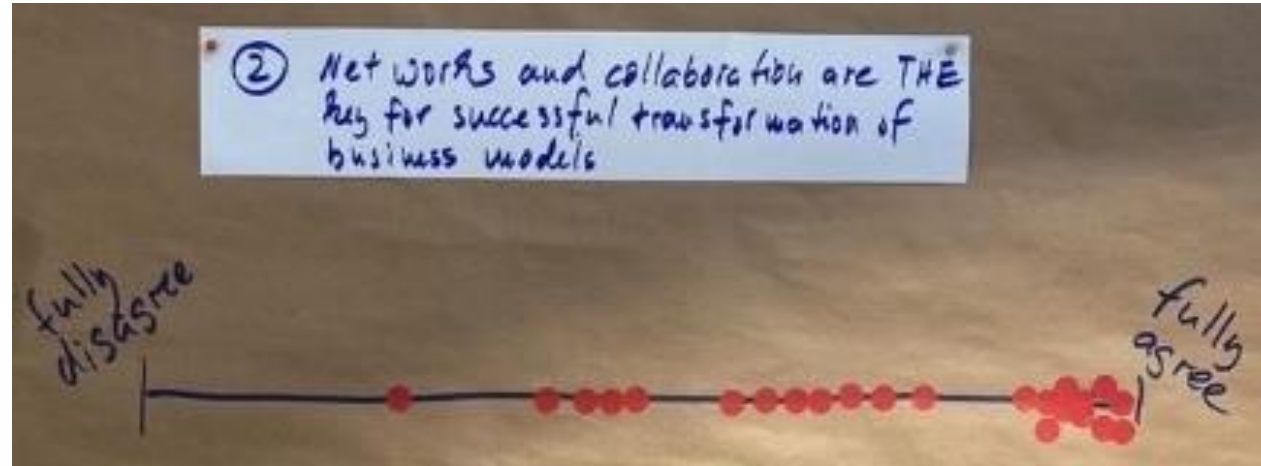
Hypothesis assessment: Hypothesis 1

We will only achieve our climate goals if most business models are transformed



- We need:
 - Standardisation
 - Regulation → long permittance processes
- Food production will not change damatically
- Our consumers also need to change their business activities and decision towards greener products „ price is still the driver“
- How to deal with „over-consumption“
- Decarbonisation increases product price
- Most BM were based on fossil fuel funds -> needs to change
- We have to change, because the world is changing
- There are business opportunities in this change
- BM are automatically changing with innovation e.g. H₂
- Collaboration for:
 - Innovation
 - Regulatory framework

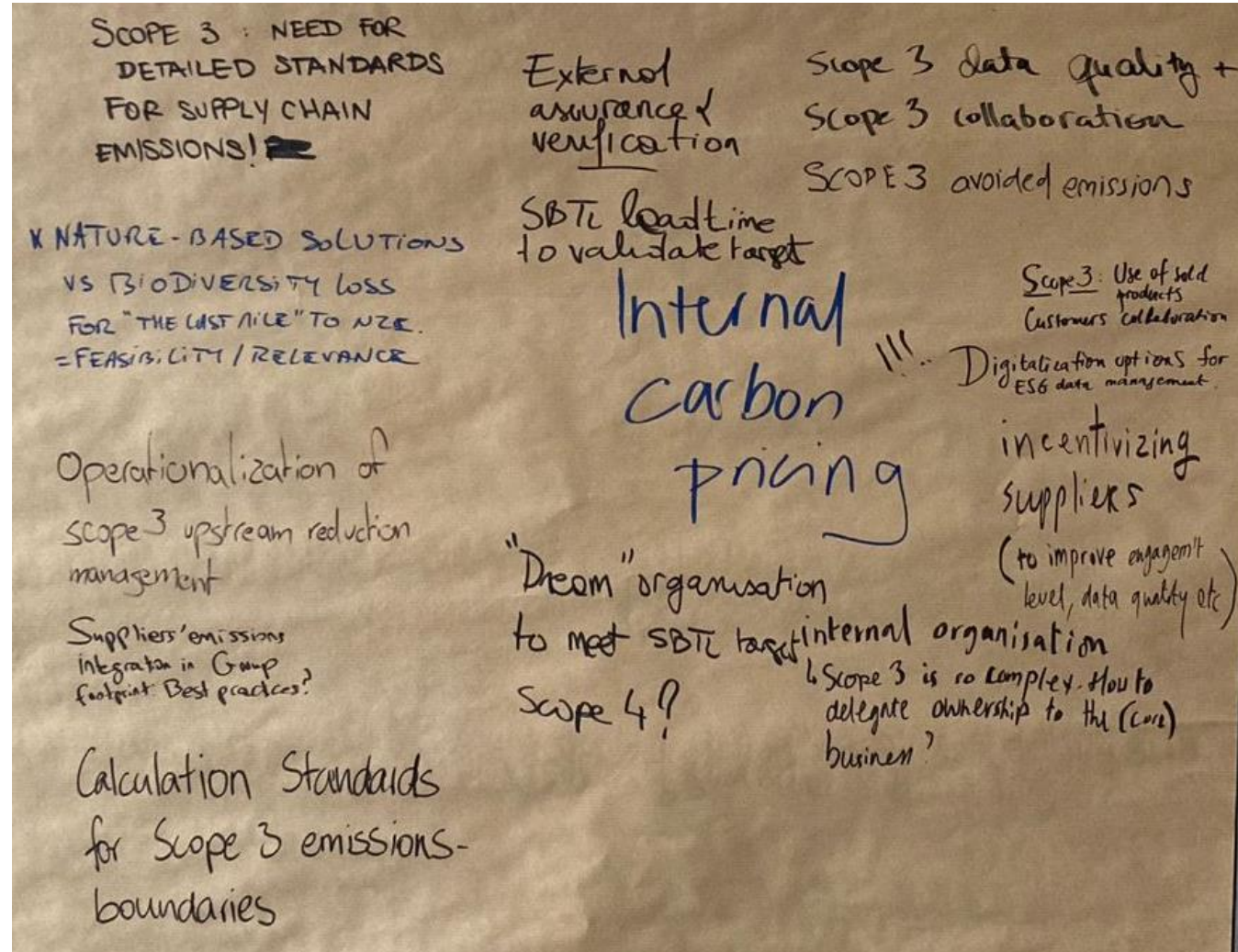

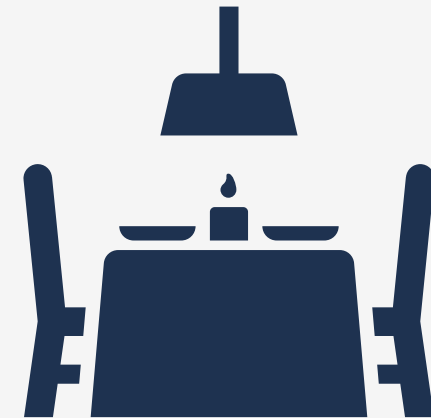
